Legal Update: PCORI Fees Due Aug. 2, 2021

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) requires health insurance issuers and self-insured plan sponsors to pay Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute fees (PCORI fees). The fees are reported and paid annually using IRS Form 720 (Quarterly Federal Excise Tax Return). READ MORE

Compliance Reminder: Medicare Part D Notices Due Before Oct. 15, 2021

Plan sponsors must provide the annual Creditable Coverage disclosure notice to Medicare-eligible individuals before Oct. 15, 2021; the start date of the annual enrollment period for Medicare Part D. CMS has provided model disclosure notices for employers to use. <u>READ MORE</u>
